


Content creation

How to obtain and maintain the consistency

Peer review of EUPHIX documents

- Partner reviewers: review the general impression, user-friendliness and goal attainment
- External reviewers: experts in the area, evaluate the validity and the reliability of the document and sources used



Selection criteria of data

- Data availability (existing databases, reviews, special reports)
 - Up-to-date enough to be relevant
 - Credible source and methods of original collection known
 - European Union (25 countries), soon: EU-27
 - EFTA countries: Iceland, Norway and Switzerland (not Liechtenstein)
 - If available: EU-15, EU-25 average, later: EU-27
- DEMO ECHI indicator



EUpHoci and policy relevance

EUpHocus: A broader subject or knowledge element presented in a synthetic review, e.g. Smoking and public health in the EU;

- incorporates several EUpHacts;
- the choice is guided by policy relevance;
- it is cross-cutting and;
- has a flexible structure.
