2006 – 2008 : Three years of work to develop a prototype

- 38 ECHI topics published (*23 data presentations*)
- 5 broader themes published
- Over 100 visitors each day
- 16 authors & reviewers

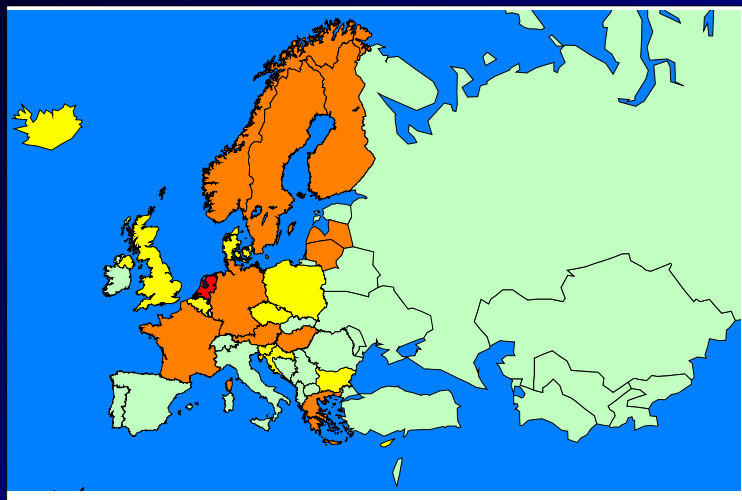

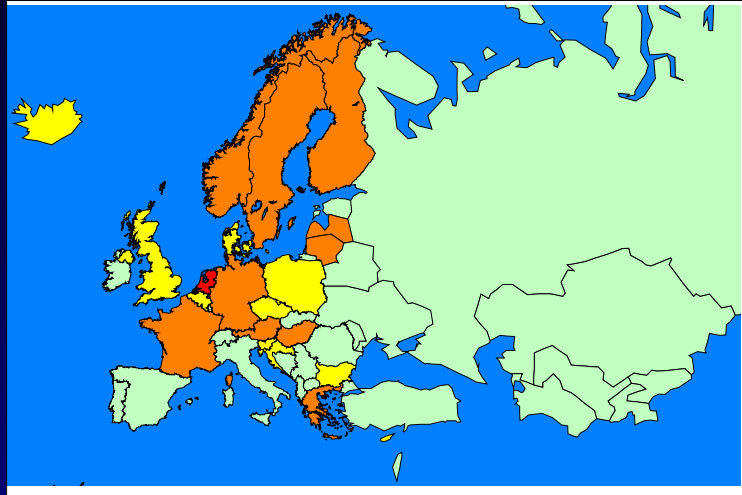

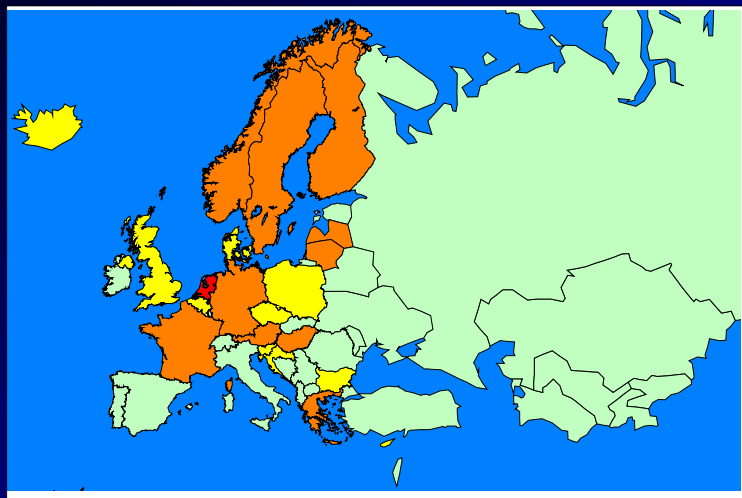
